



INTRODUCTION

Social Work aims to maximize the development of human potential and the fulfilment of human needs, through Working with and enabling people to achieve the best possible levels of personal and social wellbeing. The department aims to prepare students to integrate knowledge, skills, ethics and values of Social work. As a part ofour curriculumthe social work department every year organizes various community programmes, study tour ,Tribal visits and Rural camps. The department of Social Work, (BSW) Ganesar Arts and Science College, Melaisivapuri. organised 5 days Tribal camp for BSW students from 20 FEB 2023 TO 24 FEB 2023 at Yercaud, Salem (District). The Camp Focused on providing crosscultural exposure and understand the core of tribal society life. Their problems and needs and help in preparing a plan for social work practice and community development. Furthermore, social work camp provided an opportunity to identify the needs and interests of the people through professional interactions. The camp was exclusively organized by the Social work students, the faculties provided background support to the students.

Objectives of the Camp

- To knowledge about the various NGOs and its functions
- To enable students, understand the socio-economic conditions of tribal life
- ToHelp students integrate essential values for life
- To develop personal and professional skills and
- To facilitate self-development in process like planning, decision making,
- To learn to work together as a team programme organizing, executing coordination, recording, report writing and self-evaluating.

Activities On The Days

Day-1 (20 Feb 2023)

The Tribal Camp began on 20th of February, 2023at 6pm in the BothimaramOldage home at Salem. The program was held from 5pm to 8pm. Managing Director Mrs.Rajarajeshwari welcomed the social work trainees and faculties. Deputy Managing Director Mrs.Prema welcomed the students delivered a welcome address. Managing Director of Bothimaramoldage Home, she outlined the daily tasks and experiences of the Nursing Home Services. There are three categories of dependent elderly parents abandoned by their children and elderly whose children are sent monthly expenses. There are a total of 95 senior citizens in this oldage home. She told about the physical health and mental health problems of the elderly. She explained about elderly care work. Students asked questions related to health and mental health of the elderly. Managing Director gave a very clear answer for the students to understand easily. Finally the students delivered a vote of thanks.

Day-2(Feb-21)

On the second day of the camp, the students visited National Law Foundation. The program was held from 6 to 8 pm. Law Foundation Coordinator Mr.Sundar delivered the welcome speech and stated the objectives of the Law Foundation. Director Mr. SethupathiBA.BL., spoke about the Basic Laws and gave awareness about the Right to Information Act. Explained the rules and procedures of RTI Act and informed about how to get information through RTI Act. He explained the human rights protection laws to the students. He answered the doubts raised by the students regarding the law. Students learned about Basic Laws, Human Rights act and Right to Information Act. Finally the students delivered a vote of thanks.

Day-3(Feb-22)

Third day of the camp Students visited Yercaud RehabilitationCenter. This rehabilitation center program was held from 10 am to 1 pm. Director Victor welcomed the students and explained the work of the Rehabilitation Center. Taught the students about treatment and counseling for drug addicts. 


