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#### Report on the Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell Meeting

#### Introduction

In 09.09.2022, the Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell of [College/University Name] held a crucial meeting to introduce new strategies for combating sexual harassment on and off campus. - Monitor the bus environment to identify any incidents of harassment.
- Serve as immediate points of contact for students facing issues during their travel.
- Report any incidents to the cell for further action.

# **Planning and Implementation**

Dr. M. Subarna outlined the plan for implementing this new initiative. The steps include:

Selection Process: Representatives will be selected based on their willingness to help and their ability to handle sensitive situations with discretion and empathy.

Training: All selected representatives will undergo training sessions to equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge to handle complaints effectively.

Awareness Campaign: An awareness campaign will be launched to inform students about the new initiative and encourage them to approach their department or bus representatives without hesitation.

#### **Discussion and Feedback**
