Report 2018-2019


Students who are admitted for the 2018–2019 academic year are given an affidavit against discrimination. Every student must promise, under pain of legal consequence, that they will neither engage in nor support ragging at the college. The college explicitly states that any incidence of ragging will have severe repercussions, including legal action. To try and raise awareness, the college grounds are covered in a large number of anti-ragging posters. Students who have been admitted are given a thorough orientation that covers the college's anti-ragging policies. The Anti-Ragging helpline number and the Anti-Ragging reporting forms must be made known to the public. In the event of any ragging incidents, the website provides the contact details for the anti-ragging committee for ease of use. Thus, the committee has not received any information.

Justification:

The anti-ragging report and circular for the academic year 2018-2019 reflected the Ganesar College of Arts and Science's strong commitment to creating a safe and welcoming environment for all students. The formation of an Anti-Ragging Committee and Squads, along with the detailed dissemination of their contact information on the college website and through faculty, ensures easy access and support for students. The college's proactive measures, such as the mandatory affidavits against ragging, widespread awareness campaigns, and thorough orientation programs, underline the institution's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging.
