- This is to let all first-year students know that the following measures, among others, have been implemented to guarantee that there is no room for harassment on college campuses.
 - For this reason, the College established the Anti-Ragging Committee. The college website has uploaded the members' details for the Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad, making them easily accessible to students. In addition, the Anti-Ragging Squads were established with the intention of monitoring, stopping, and responding appropriately.
- The College website has all the information on the Anti-Ragging Squad. All faculty have already received copies of the lists.
- Students are now advised that they should not be reluctant to report any grievances originating from any type of misbehaviour by a fellow student to any member of the Anti-Ragging Committee or Squad.
- You can be confident that the authorities would take harsh measures against the perpetrators as soon as an incidence of this kind is confirmed.
- In order to provide juniors with unrestricted mobility inside the college campus, every effort is being made to prevent students from engaging in any behaviour that could be interpreted as harassment.
- If a student has any complaints or feels that they could be harassed, they should not hesitate to speak with any college official.

For convenience, the website offers the anti-ragging committee's contact information in case of any ragging incidents. As a result, the committee has not heard from the students.

By requiring affidavits against ragging and clearly communicating the severe consequences for such actions, the college emphasizes its zero-tolerance policy.
