- For the academic year 2021–2022, newly admitted students receive an affidavit against discrimination. Every student must swear under penalty of law that they will neither engage in nor promote ragging within the College. It is also made plain that there will be severe repercussions and legal action for any instances of ragging at the College. To increase awareness, there are several anti-ragging posters posted all over the college grounds.
- Newly admitted students are given a thorough orientation program that covers the college's anti-ragging policies. This includes letting people know about the Anti-Ragging reporting forms and the Anti-Ragging helpline number. The website provides the anti-ragging committee's contact details for ease of access in the event of any ragging incident. Consequently, the committee has not received a single complaint regarding any incident of ragging. Nonetheless, ragging awareness campaigns are a common practice on campuses.
